Cranes could also be transported to various construction sites on the road as they drive themselves, that eliminates the need for extra transport vehicles. One drawback of a truck crane is that it is not stable enough sitting on tires alone in order to be able to lift the major loads which a hydraulic crane can handle. Therefore, to be able to fix this issue, outriggers can be extended from the deck. The outriggers use hydraulic pressure in order to lift the truck slightly off of the ground, making it balanced and stable. Crawler cranes feature big tracks on the bottom of the crane. These massive tracks are like the ones seen on other construction machinery such as backhoes and bulldozers. The tracks allow the crane to move around a construction locations successfully.
